Below are brief descriptions of the various volunteer opportunities available. Please keep in mind that additional duties may be required as needed.

Please allow flexibility as dates and times may vary and are dependent on weather and play.

ADMISSIONS: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Ticket and badge sales
- Checking spectators credentials
- Distribute wrist bands and will-call tickets
- Greeter/ambassadors for tournament as spectators enter the gates

Requirements: Friendly and upbeat personality.

CADDIE SERVICES: Monday, June 3– Sunday, June 9

- Assist the caddie master in the caddie tent
- Direct caddies where to get food
- Assist with caddie registration

CARTS & SHUTTLES: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

- Assist with cart storage, distribution and preparation
- Provide transportation and shuttle services on-course for Volunteers

Requirements: Must attend training on Saturday June 1, 2024 and have a valid drivers license.

CLUBHOUSE COMMITTEE: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

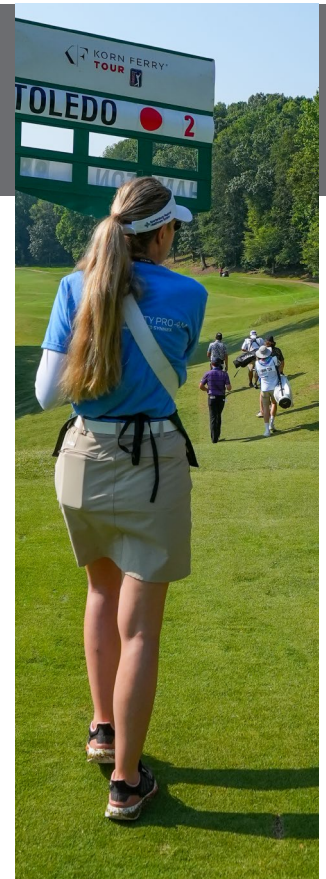
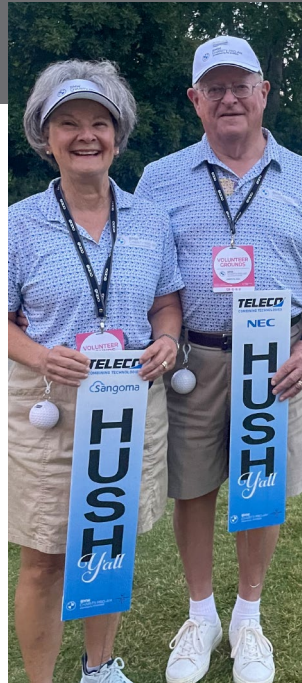
- Ensure all guests have proper meal credentials
- Inside position
- Greet all guests

Requirements: Friendly and upbeat personality

CONTESTANT SERVICES: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

- Provide information of local concierge services to players and their spouses
- Distribute approved tournament credentials upon request to professionals
- Provide assistance to anyone seeking medical attention

Requirements: Friendly and upbeat personality.



FAMILY FUN ZONE: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Assist participating organizations with activities

Requirements: Friendly and outgoing. Must work well with children and be energetic. Majority of the time will be spent on your feet.

GENERAL DUTIES: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

- Fill in on any committee as needed

GOLF CHANNEL: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Assist television crews on site with the coverage of the event
- Assist with carrying cameras and television equipment
- Shuttle camera operators

Requirements: Volunteers must be physically capable of carrying equipment and walking the course. Must be at least 21 years of age and must work all four days.

MARSHAL: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Provide ball spotting
- Control noise and movement of spectators

Requirements: Open to volunteers 16 years of age and older.

ON-COURSE SERVICES: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

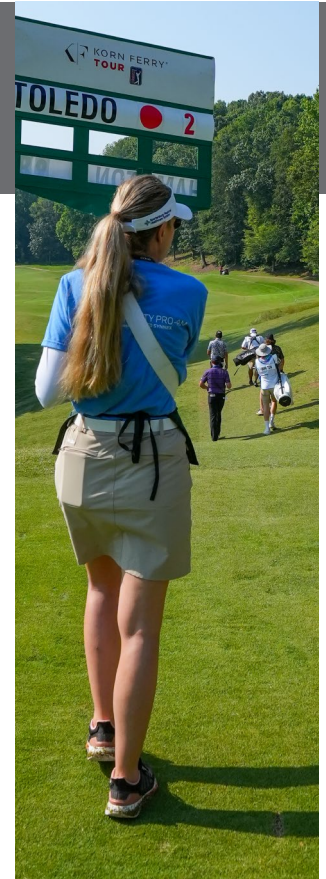
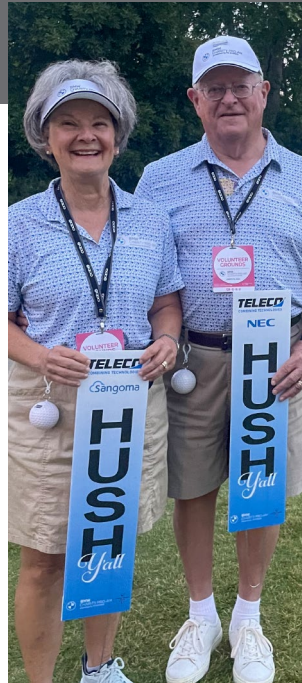
- Maintain golfer's beverage stations on-course
- Maintain beverage station in skybox's, Tournament and officials office, and locker room

Requirements: Able to lift 20 lbs.

SCORING SUPPORT: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Support Shotlink bugs and devices

Requirements: Must be able to work all four days.

SHOTLINK GREENSIDE OPERATOR:

Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Utilize digital device located on each Green for data capture, lasering the ball to calculate exact distance
- Input information into a tablet

Requirements: Must have general golf scoring knowledge, comfortable using basic technology and physically able to walk around the green for periods of time. Must complete Shotlink online training and attend a PGA training session during tournament week.

SKYBOX HOSPITALITY: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Work in private hospitality areas
- Assist with checking credentials
- Marshal during play
- Be available for tournament questions

STANDARD BEARER: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Walk with each group carrying the standard sign with scoring

Requirements: Must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes carrying a 6-8 lb sign. Must attend PGA TOUR training session. An understanding of golf is recommended, however, the Walking Scorer will be able to assist with posting scores correctly. Open to volunteers 14 years of age and older.

UNIFORMS: Saturday, May 18 & Saturday, May 25

- Organize and distribute volunteer uniforms prior to the tournament

VOLUNTEER SERVICES: Monday, June 3 – Sunday, June 9

- Assist with volunteer check-in
- Maintain volunteer meal areas
- Offer general assistance to other volunteers

WALKING SCORER: Thursday, June 6 – Sunday, June 9

- Accompany each group of players and enter scores on PGA Tour equipment
- Assist Standard Bearer with correct posting of scores

Requirements: Must be able to briskly walk 18-hole round. Must attend the Korn Ferry Tour training session.
